



Taxonomy Upgrade - Q2 rollout

The SPS database is being updated to improve functionality and accuracy across the entire platform including:

SPS Alerts, Market Coverage, and sector-level analyses.

- Access four defined tiers and over 560 options at the lowest (subindustry) level
- Improve your search with primary/secondary structure for deals with multiple tags
- Layer the new Business Function field on top of existing queries e.g., "Distributor" within consumer products
